Overview of the Course

“The Bible makes so much sense now!”

The Stranger on the Road to Emmaus course gives an excellent overview of the main message of the Bible. It joins together

important Old and New Testament events to show the identity of God and the nature of sin, all the time answering two questions:

“Who is Jesus?” and “What is the story of the cross and the tomb all about?”

This course helps a person understand the main message of Bible.

This course is ideal for people who come from a nominal Christian background, whether Catholic, Protestant or Orthodox. It assumes people taking the course believe there is only one God who is a person, not a force.

Features of the Course

Based on the Gospel of John: The course is based on the gospel of John and it gives necessary background stories to help the student appreciate the background to the gospel. The course assumes the student knows very little, if anything, about the Bible.

Chronological: The course starts with the creation of the universe, and then progressively describes important Old Testament events. The course then moves into the New Testament to explain the meaning of the cross and the tomb. The main message of the Bible is tied together into one universal, all-encompassing account.

Objective: The course allows the Bible to speak for itself as it presents the good news about the Lord Jesus Christ - the greatest man who ever lived who offers men and women the greatest gift ever given. There is no arm-twisting to believe. The message is presented objectively; the decision to believe or not to believe is left to the reader.

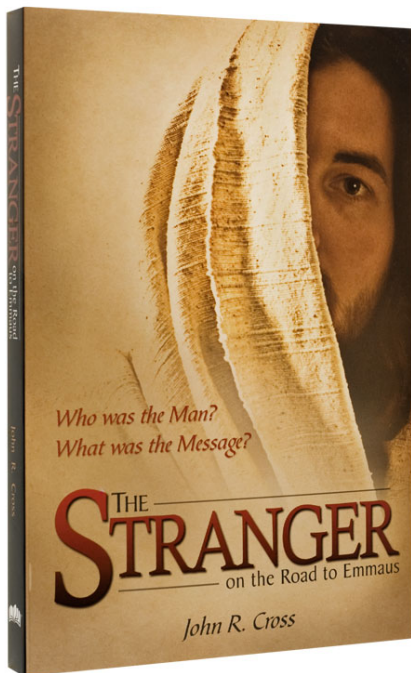
Bible verses: Told as a story, the course uses 1,177 Bible verses as it explains the message of Bible.

Illustrated: The course uses over 100 drawings, maps and diagrams to help explain the story.

Appropriate for these audiences:

The course is suitable for adults and teens, but it can also be understood by children as young as 10. It has also been produced for people who know only a little about the Bible. The course is also useful for discipleship and back-to-basics teaching of believers. It is appropriate for people who come from a Christian background.
